Students meeting the general admission requirements of the University may be accepted as an undeclared major. Registration to music classes by undeclared student or student with a major other than music is subject to prerequisite and music major status restrictions as indicated in the UNC Catalog. Students can be designated as music majors and accepted by the School of Music after a successful audition and School of Music application.

***Minimum Proficiencies.** Minimum proficiency in music fundamentals and ear training as assessed by the Music Theory Placement Exam to enter MUS 113/114.

Minor Required – No minor required.

This worksheet is a recommended schedule to complete your bachelor's degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

Notes

1. MUS 100 Recitals, Concerts, and Productions must be taken each semester in residence.
2. Students must take Individual Performance during each semester in residence.
3. Students must take Major Musical Organizations during each semester in residence. See "Major Musical Organizations" in the UNC Catalog.
4. All BM, Instrumental majors must take the Piano Placement Examination upon registering for their first semester.
 - a. Depending on their Placement Exam results, Brass and Percussion Instrumental majors may be placed in MUS 160, 161, 260, 261, 271 and/or 471, and these 4 credits will count as 4 of the 12 music electives.
 - b. Strings and Woodwind Instrumental majors may take as few or as many piano classes as necessary to achieve the skills necessary to pass a mandatory Piano Proficiency Exam, typically taken the sophomore year. If a Strings or Woodwind student scores high enough on the Piano Placement Exam to waive some or all of the 4 piano credits, they will need to take additional Music elective credits to fulfill the total of 12 Music electives.
5. LAC Category 3A is fulfilled by MUS 243. MUS 143 fulfills the requirements of the 68 credits of the Required Major credits. To fulfill Liberal Arts Category 3, a student must also take a course from subgroups 3b, 3c, or 3d.
6. The student must pass an upper-level qualifying examination, determined by the performance area, before he/she may enroll in the 400-level instruction. This examination is to be taken by the end of the fourth semester of 200-level instruction. If the student does not pass this examination on the first try, he/she may retake it once in the subsequent semester.
7. String students may substitute an elective in lieu of MUS 209/309/313 or 460 (music technology or music business course) in consultation with the advisor.
8. String students may substitute an elective in lieu of MUS 403 in consultation with the advisor.
9. A Half Junior Recital and Full Senior Recital are required.
