Admission Requirement – All degree program areas in the School of Theatre Arts and Dance (Theatre Arts and Musical Theatre) require an audition/interview for entrance into the degree program. Students interested in majoring in theatre arts or musical theatre may be accepted as “Undeclared” if they meet the general admission requirements of the University. If a student has been accepted by the school after a successful audition or interview, then they will be designated as a theatre arts or musical theatre major. Consideration of student acceptance will be made by the Admission Committee in the school in accordance with the student’s audition or interview resume, letters of recommendation and academic record. The student must apply and be accepted to one of the concentration areas.
