Admission Requirement:

All degree program areas in the School of Theatre Arts and Dance (Theatre Arts and Musical Theatre) require an audition, interview, or other application for entrance into the degree program. Students interested in majoring in Theatre Arts or Musical Theatre may be accepted as "Undeclared" if they meet the general admission requirements of the University. If a student has been accepted by the school after a successful audition or interview, they will then be designated as a Theatre Arts or Musical Theatre major. Consideration of student acceptance will be made by the Admission Committee of the School in accordance with the student's audition or interview, resume, letters of recommendation, and academic record. The student must apply and be accepted to one of the concentration areas. Information concerning auditions, interviews, or essays for Theatre Arts programs may be requested from the School of Theatre Arts and Dance, University of Northern Colorado, Frasier Hall, Greeley, CO 80639; phone: 970.351.2991.

Minor:

No minor required.

This worksheet is a <u>recommended schedule</u> to complete your bachelor's degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: Earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation.

Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.

Notes:

1. All Theatre Education students must take 8 credits of THEA 100 Individual Performance in Theatre. This requirement may be met by taking a minimum of 4 credits of THEA 100; the remaining 2 credits may be completed by taking a combination of THEA 100 and THEA 110.

2. Any student receiving a grade of "C-" or lower in a course in the required core or concentration area must retake the course until a grade of "C" or higher is achieved.

3. The Colorado Commission on Higher Education and this program require the completion of a yearly assessment process. The assessment, which includes an evaluation of your year's progress as well as a yearly audition or interview, may be the basis for your continuance in this program area.

4. A teaching minor is highly recommended. Students must remember that in the public schools of the State of Colorado, more than half the teaching load must be done in the area of licensure. A student desiring licensure should be prepared for many additional requirements in content and in methods and observation in the minor field.

5. Students must successfully pass program specific PRAXIS before student teaching.
