AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Note: An accompanist will be provided.

1. Prepare 16-32 bars each from two songs of a contrasting nature. One song should demonstrate your technical vocal abilities, the other should demonstrate your ability to coordinate your vocal technique with acting and movement. These two selections should be contrasting in style, i.e. classical/musical-theatre or ballad/up tempo.
2. Prepare a 30-second to one-minute monologue.
3. A dance audition is optional. Contact Di Smice for further info at 970-351-2930.

Your audition panel will consist of members of the Musical Theatre Committee, which includes members of the voice, acting, and dance faculty.

Following your audition, you will be informed in writing by mid-March as to your acceptance into the Musical Theatre Program.
