## Call for Papers

### The Call

All UNC School of Art and Design are invited to submit a 200 word abstract to give a 20-minute talk on a topic within the history of art.

### About the Art History Symposium

The UNC Art History Symposium is a competitive opportunity for art and design students to present their original research on a topic within art history. Students submit an abstract selected for a public presentation of current scholarly research. If chosen, they present their work at the Art History Symposium which allows them to develop the materials, conceptual sophistication, and public speaking skills needed to pursue advanced academic or professional opportunities upon graduation from UNC.

### The Jury Process

A faculty panel and guest juror will review completed abstracts; the selected abstracts will proceed to the **UNC School of Art and Design 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Art History Symposium on Friday, February 16**. Finalists will present their proposal in person to the panel. One finalist will be selected as this year's Symposium Winner and will present their paper at the **2018 CAC Front Range Art History Symposium at Colorado College in Colorado Springs on April 14th, 2018**.

### How to Submit

Email the following materials to Director of Galleries Pamela Campanaro by **Friday, January 26 at 5:00 pm**:

- 200 word abstract saved as a PDF;
- A current resume.

Please note: Hard copy submissions will not be accepted or returned, and incomplete submissions will not be reviewed.

Students should propose topics derived from completed research papers. We recommend that students work with a faculty mentor and the Artist Help Desk to prepare their presentations.
