UNC Orchestras Solo Competition 2022

Friday, April 1, 2022, 6-10pm, Campus Commons Rehearsal Studio

Departmental preliminaries

Each Area should hold a preliminary competition to determine the finalists who will compete on March 31. The deadline for this preliminary round is Monday, March 23. **All results are due by 5pm on Monday March 28, in order to allow sufficient time to organize the competition final, and to allow finalists to book accompanists. Late submissions will not be accepted.** The maximum numbers each department may advance to the Finals are as follows: Brass/Percussion = 3, Woodwinds = 2, Voice = 2, Strings = 2, Keyboard = 2

Awards

Zero or one winner will be selected, depending upon the quality of the best auditions. The winner will perform their complete solo with the UNC Symphony during the 2022-2023 season.

Audition Materials

Check that the work you propose to perform has orchestral parts currently available for sale or rental in this country. Publisher information for <u>orchestral parts</u> must appear on your entry form. Preliminary and final rounds of the competition must be accompanied by piano.

Eligibility

The competition is open to any UNC student currently enrolled in applied music, who receives approval from his/her applied instructor, and who will be able to perform during the 2022-2023 academic year. Pieces requiring up to four soloists are acceptable. Vocalists are required to present a substantial work, perhaps a song cycle, or other extended work, comparable to an instrumental concerto. No student may enter the competition on more than one piece during the same competition. Previous winners may not compete again. The winner will be responsible for his/her own travel expenses to Greeley.

Memorization

There is no memorization requirement. However, any instructor may require memorization from his/her student(s).

Judges

There will be three judges. The Director of Orchestras will <u>not</u> be a judge. The studio professors of finalists will receive comment sheets from the judges.

Application Deadline for Finalists

Monday, March 28 by 5pm: <u>FINALISTS ONLY</u> must return the completed entry form to Administrative Assistant in the Band/Orchestra Office. No late applications will be accepted.
