The Afterlives of Truth and Musicals, Jake Johnson (Oklahoma City University)

**Abstract:** Lies, to invoke Mary Douglas, are stories out of place. Musicals are also stories out of place. They invest in the not-yet and enable a certain parlaying with reality that has come to be an attractive quality for communities all over America that see truth as a roadblock to worlds they prefer. Musical theater lies in the middle of America's sense of what is real and what it prefers to believe is real.

But the age of post-truth is pulling at the seams of what makes musicals a powerful dreamcoat in this country. In this talk, Johnson will consider how musicals and truth have come, will come, or are already coming to an end. Johnson invokes the concept of an afterlife for all of its meanings. Musicals and beliefs are central to the idea of American building and rebuilding in the imagination

again and again. What happens when musicals and the truth they disguise have fulfilled their purpose? What awaits them? What becomes of us?
