Each major and/or concentration may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. **Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.**

- LAA1 Refers to the LAC Arts & Humanities: Arts & Expression.
- Art & Design students must complete the Foundation requirements before they can begin their advanced art studies. The Foundation Courses include Art 181, 182, 183, 184, and 234. Students also must successfully complete the Foundation Portfolio.
- Courses that have an “/ “ between them means that if you decide to take one course that semester, you must take the other course the next time it pops up in this plan.
- **Must Maintain a 3.0 GPA as an Art Ed major**
- Courses with two asterisks (**): THESE COURSES REQUIRE OBSERVATION HOURS. Art 248 (25 hours), Art 345 (60 hours including an arranged art teaching experience), Art 445 (60 hours including an arranged art teaching experience), Art 441 (15 hours embedded in the course although there may be a few hours outside of class depending on community partner needs)
