### What? Why? When?

- What is the Praxis?
  - Test designed to assess a beginning music teachers knowledge
- Why do you have to take the praxis?
  - Required for mus414, edse130, and student teaching
- When do you have to take the Praxis?
  - Before senior year
  - It is recommended to take it sometime during your junior year
  - Do not wait until the last minute!!
    - It may take up to or longer than 2 weeks to receive test scores
    - You have to wait at least 21 days before being able to retake the test

    - Form

## What do I study? Non-Listening History + Lit

- You should know the following from every time period:
  - Composers
  - Performers
  - Characteristics of compositions
  - Examples of compositions
  - Defining ensembles
- You should be able to identify the following about World Music:
  - Instruments and where they are from (koto from Japan, ect)
  - Ensembles and where they come from (gamelan music from Indonesia, ect)
  - Genres and where they come from (Polish mazurka, ect)

### What do I study? Non-Listening Theory + Comp

- Must be literate in treble clef, alto clef, bass clef, and tenor clef
- Transposition between clef and key signature
- Figured bass, part writing rules, chord progressions
- Instrumental and vocal ranges
- Vocabulary (tempo markings, expressive markings, ect)
- Score reading and analysis

### • Strings

- Care of string instruments and materials
- Fingerings, playing technique
- American String Teacher Association (ASTA)

### • Band

- Care of band instruments and materials
- Transposition, fingerings, playing technique
- Colorado Bandmasters Association (CBA)


- Use flashcards so you can study while moving

# Test Day Tips

- Maintain your normal routine
  - Ie. If you eat breakfast, don't skip it.
- Carpool with a friend
- Don't be afraid to sing, stand, talk aloud, or move during the test
- Leave everything in your car!
  - pencils, paper, phones, watches, ect
- Wear comfortable clothes
- Drink some water and get some sleep!
- Stay positive and realistic! (don't put yourself down!)
