## MUS 100 UNC School of Music 0 Credits

Each semester, students will attend Common Hour Convocations plus a minimum of 5 concerts or productions in which you **do not perform**.

The following will count towards the **five concerts or productions per semester**:

- Professional concerts on or off-campus in any area
- Faculty recitals in any area
- On-campus guest artists in any performance area
- Up to two UNC Curricular Ensemble concerts OR Student Recitals **outside** your performance area. For example, if you are jazz guitar, these recitals cannot be jazz.

**Proof of attendance for concerts or productions:** Concert programs must have your name legibly printed and your signature on the program cover. Signed programs must be scanned into the Canvas grading shell **within 7 days of attending the event**. Please communicate with the instructor of record if you have any questions.

## Grading for MUS 100

This course is graded as pass or fail. Any unexcused absences from Common Hour events or attending less than 5 approved concerts or productions will result in failure of the course.

Concerts and Productions portion:

Signed programs must be scanned into the Canvas grading shell **within 7 days of attending the event**. These programs will be assessed as pass or fail. If a program qualifies as fail, the student may be given an opportunity to replace with a qualifying program.

Common Hour portion:

Common Hour attendance will be tracked by digital check-in and checkout. All Common Hour sessions are required. Absences must be approved by the instructor of record in advance.

This semester's class code for Common Hour attendance is **f19commonhour**.

Enroll in the class on the app prior to arriving at the concert hall. You only need to enroll in the course once for the semester.

You *must Check-in on the APP at the beginning and end of the presentation to receive credit for the event.* You'll need to enable GPS for the APP in your phone for it to find your location. Go into your phone settings to ensure GPS is enabled. **If you don't own a smartphone or tablet, we will have a physical sign-in sheet.** You'll need to sign this at the beginning and end of the presentation.

If you are found checking into the event and leaving out a discreet entrance/exit without attending, you will fail MUS 100, and be reported for breaking the code of conduct at the institution.
