### Tips:

- 1. Warm up using exercises that are similar to the music.
- 2. Practice with a metronome timing is key!
- 3. Work on isolating the hands (practicing RH only, and then LH only).
- 4. Sight Read music on snare drum and mallets daily.
- 5. Listen to MANY recordings of these pieces where applicable. It will give you the right perspective on the music, especially on dynamics/dynamic contrast, muffling, style, and more!
- 6. Record yourself and listen back (listen for timing, accuracy, sound quality, and musicality)
- 7. <u>Practice the audition</u>. Simulate playing the above sequence of music, in addition to isolating each section.
