Admission Requirements:

Students planning to major in music are required to submit a School of Music Application to the School of Music. Auditions are required of all applicants to the School of Music Information concerning auditions may be requested from the School of Music office.

Students meeting the general admission requirements of the University may be accepted as an undeclared major. Registration to music classes by undeclared students or students with a major other than music are subject to prerequisite and music major status restrictions as indicated in the UNC Catalog. Students can be designated as music majors and accepted by the School of Music after a successful audition and School of Music application.

*Minimum Proficiencies:

- Minimum proficiency in music fundamentals and ear training as assessed by the Music Theory Placement Exam to enter MUS 113 & MUS 114.
- All BME majors must take the Piano Placement Examination upon registering for their first semester to determine proficiency level and recommendations for further study, if any. BME majors may take as few or as many piano classes (MUS 160, 161, 260, 261, 271, and/or 471) as necessary to achieve the skills necessary to pass a mandatory Piano Proficiency Exam.

Minor: No minor required.

Recital: A half Senior Recital is required.

This worksheet is a <u>recommended schedule</u> to complete your bachelor's degree in 4 years. Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: Earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 40 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Core; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation.

Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.

Footnotes:

- 1. MUS 100 Recitals, Concerts, and Productions must be taken each semester in residence.
- 2. Students must take Individual Performance during each semester in residence.
- 3. Students must take Major Musical Organizations during each semester in residence. See "Major Musical Organizations" in the UNC Catalog.
- 4. EDFE 110 PTEP Application must be taken before MUS 210 Introduction to Music Education.
- 5. The student must pass an upper-level qualifying examination determined by the performance area before he/she may enroll in the 400 level instruction. This examination is to be taken by the end of the fourth semester of 200 level instruction. If the student does not pass this examination on the first try, he/she may retake it once in the subsequent semester.
- 6. Piano majors will take four credits of MUS 270 (Individual Performance in Voice) or choose four credits from a combination of the following courses instead: MUS 270 Individual Performance in Voice, MUS 470 Individual Performance in Voice, MUS 237 English and Italian Diction, or MUS 238 German and French Diction, bringing their total requirements to 126 credits.
- 7. Voice majors will take both MUS 237 (English and Italian Diction) and MUS 238 (German and French Diction), bringing their total requirements to 124 credits.
- 8. MUS 237 and MUS 238 are offered in alternating years in the Fall semester.
