



School of Art and Design In-Person Portfolio Review

What should I expect or bring with me?

- Bring 5 to 10 physical works to be reviewed.
 - We will have 6-foot tables set up for you to display your work.
 - Bring display-ready work, a cleanly cut mat, mounted on foam core or similar.

- You can also bring a computer or tablet with additional images of your work.
 - In some cases, progress pictures are helpful.
- Be ready to talk briefly about our work. Highlight any themes or ideas you are exploring. How does your work reflect you as an artist?
- Are there any questions you have or things you would like to hear from us?

Upon arrival, artists can set work up on the tables provided in the Campus Commons Gallery. A short welcome session starts at 9:00 in the performance hall. Once that is finished, we recommend attending session one about financial aid. During this time faculty will review student artwork amongst themselves. After session one students will meet with faculty to discuss their work. After those conversations, we will announce scholarships at 11:45. Then, you'll have a chance to grab lunch at the University Center or somewhere in town. After lunch meet us in the gallery at 1:00 for a walking tour of the School of Art and Design. A full campus tour is available from 3:00 – 4:00.

- 3:00 – 4:00pm Optional session 2: Full campus tour including west campus with Admissions Ambassadors.

Scholarships are often offered at this event. To receive the funds, you must confirm enrollment by May 1 before starting UNC in the fall semester after your senior year. UNC application can be found [HERE](#). Once accepted to UNC, you also must apply for the [School of Art and Design online Scholarship Application](#) to receive any potential additional funds. Notification of these funds will be announced around May 1. The funds will appear in your student accounts the first or second week of the fall semester and will be divided into semester increments over 4 years.
