Admission Requirement - All BFA degree program areas in the School of Theatre Arts and Dance (STAD) require an audition, interview, or other application for entrance into the degree program. Students interested in majoring in Theatre Arts may be accepted as "Undeclared" if they meet the general admission requirements of the University. Consideration of student acceptance into a BFA degree or K-12 Teaching Emphasis will be made by the Admission Committee of the School in accordance with the student's audition or interview, resume/work samples, letters of recommendation, and academic record. The student must apply and be accepted.
